### Non-Refundable Expenses

1. New Student Application Expense: \$30

2. Enrollment/Re-Enrollment Expense: \$50

- Due by May 31<sup>st</sup>; increases to \$250 on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 3. **Withdrawal Expense:** In the event that a student needs to withdrawal after enrollment, a \$750 fee will be charged.
- 4. Tuition Payment Options:
  - Plan 12 12 monthly payments June 1<sup>st</sup> May 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - Pay in full Receive a 3% discount when the entire tuition amount is paid before June 15th.

# Multiple Sibling Discount:

• Families with two or more children enrolled receive a 2% discount on total tuition.

### **Family Volunteer Hours:**

• 3 hours per month per family, or \$10 per hour for hours not served.

**<u>Late Payment Policy</u>**: \$25 per account if payment is not received by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month.

After School Extended Care: \$5.00 hourly rate per child (\$1.25 per 15-minute interval).

#### **Part-Time Program**

Students in the part-time program are only on-campus during their class times. This program is available to students 1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade.

- Part-time students in 1st-5th will be required to be in class one-half day, either in the morning or in the afternoon.
- Part-time students in 6th-12th will be able to take up to 6 courses at BHCA.

### **Dual-Enrollment Program**

Dual-Enrollment students may take public school courses in addition to being enrolled at BHCA. Public school-sanctioned extracurricular activities do not require dual-enrollment.

- Available to students in grades 6<sup>th</sup> 12<sup>th</sup>.
- Students may take up to 6 courses at BHCA in addition to their courses in the public school.

### **Dual-Credit Program**

Dual-Credit is a state program that allows students who meet eligibility requirements to take courses at Black Hills State University or another accredited college or university and obtain college and high school credits at the same time. This is an excellent way for students to get a jump start on their college education and save a considerable amount of money at the same time.

- Available to eligible high school juniors and seniors.
- Students are allowed to take classes at BHCA in addition to their Dual-Credit courses.
